

REGISTRATION INFORMATION



Newtown Quilters' Guild Quilt Show "A Thread Runs Through It", October 8-9, 2022 Newtown Middle School Newtown, PA

Please use the Guild website to register your quilt(s) this year. The site address is <http://www.newtownquiltersguild.org/members-only---2022-show-info.html>.

The purpose of registration is to let us know the number and kind of quilts that you wish to enter in the show so we can plan for the available space at the venue. We have restrictions on the size and number that you can enter, so we ask you to indicate your quilts by priority, so we can make sure your first choice is included. The information which you submit through our website is not visible to anyone publicly. It does not remain on the site. After you hit the "Submit" button, it is sent immediately via email to the Registration Coordinator inbox. We have enabled Google Captcha security for this form.

- **You can register up to three quilts.** A "quilt" means a quilted project that could be a bed quilt, wall hanging, bag, tuffet or table coverings, just to name a few.
- You will need to photograph your quilts and attach the photos to your registration. If you need assistance with uploading your photos, please contact our Webmaster, Lisa.
- **All quilts** (including other quilted projects) must have an identifying label on the back with your name. This may be a temporary muslin label, but it must be sewn on.
- **All quilts** measuring 60 inches or larger on one side must have a 4-inch-wide sleeve on the back for hanging. If your quilt has no sleeve, **it cannot be hung**. Smaller quilts will be pinned to the background fabric. Some larger quilts may be draped depending on space considerations. Pillows and other projects will be placed, space permitting.
- Quilt must not have been exhibited in a previous NQG show.
- Quilt registration and photography need to be completed by the August 16, 2022 Guild meeting.
- If you register multiple times, we will use the most recent registration as the final version.
- Small quilts for donation to the Small Quilts & Gift Baskets Raffle are not included in this registration process. See our monthly newsletter for information about this Raffle and how to donate your small quilt.
- You will be contacted by phone or email **in early September** to inform you which quilts are accepted. Your quilt need not be completely finished for photography but has to be completed for exhibition in the show.
- You will be responsible for delivering your quilts to the show venue, Newtown Middle School, on Friday evening, October 7. Timing will be announced when we have more information on the times for set-up for the show.
- Quilt pickup will be on Sunday, October 9, 2022, at 5 p.m. (one hour after the close of the show). **No one will be permitted to take their quilt(s) until all quilts have been taken down and accounted for.**
- **If a non-guild member will be picking up your quilt on your behalf, please provide a signed written consent permitting pick-up by that person.**
- **Newtown Quilters' Guild is not responsible for loss/theft/damage to your quilt.**
- **By submitting your quilt for exhibition in the show, you agree to the aforementioned terms of Quilt Registration.**
